Art/DT Have you ever split water on a picture you've drawn and been heartbroken that the running colours ruined your art? When you add water to water-based inks (like those found in most felt tip markers) the soluble colour mixes with the water and "bleeds" across the page. While this can be annoying, as in the example above, we can use it to our advantage. Watch Miss Bailey's YouTube video, which shows the different ways we can use ink bleeding to make interesting art, and then create your own image based on your favourite method: Ink blow art, watercolour texture art or sponging art.
