

Did you know that most of the world's volcanoes can be found in the Pacific Ocean basin? They form a ring shape around the basin and are known as the ring of fire! Leif Eriksson, who was an explorer from Iceland, is believed to have crossed the Atlantic to North America 500 years before Christopher Columbus. Earth's oceans, seas and waters make our planet look blue from space.

The deepest point on Earth is called Challenger Deep in the Mariana Trench in the Pacific Ocean. It is near the Philippines, Japan, Indonesia and New Guinea. It's 10,920 metres or 35,827 feet deep!

Did you know that the Southern Ocean is the youngest of all the oceans? It's only 30 million years old! The Lion's Mane Jellyfish lives in the Arctic Ocean and it eats fish, plankton and even other jellyfish! It grows to be up to 8 feet long. Almost 40% of the oil we use comes from the Indian Ocean.
