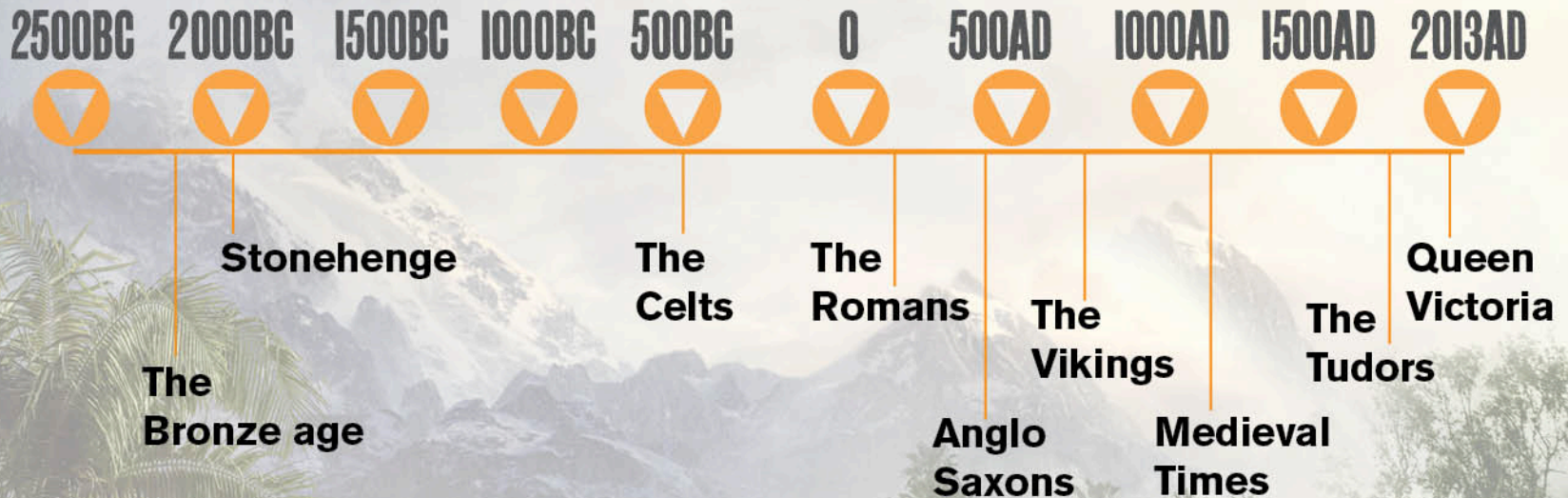

DINO-INVESTIGATORS: IDENTIFICATION



Remember what the caretaker said:

“There was a massive skull with a blunt nose and large round eye sockets. The jaws were filled with dozens of sharp pointed teeth. The skeleton’s pelvis was in the middle of its body with the head, ribcage and two short forelimbs on one side being balanced by a huge, tapering tail on the other.
