
Marine Mammals


Are warm blooded.

Have lungs, so they need to breathe air instead of getting oxygen from the water.



We are mammals.

Have hair or fur.




Fish

Are cold blooded.


Have bones.

Have gills instead of lungs, to breathe under water.



Have fins not legs.

Lay their eggs in water.




Sharks

Are cold blooded.


Are fish, but do not have bones.

Have gills on the side of their head, to breathe under water.



Have fins not legs.

There are over 350 different kinds of sharks.






Molluscs

Are cold blooded.

Have soft bodies with no backbone.

Usually have a shell, although some do not.



Are invertebrates.

Examples are scallop, conch, cuttlefish, squid.
